TAKE NOTICE that on April 13, 1993 the Town Board does adopt, as part of the Town Code of Ordinances, the following chapters as provided for under 66.035, Wis. Stats., 1989:

Chapter 6, entitled MUNICIPAL COURT ORDINANCE. Chapter 7, entitled ENVIRONMENTAL ORDINANCE.

TAKE NOTICE that Ordinance 93-2 is a re-adoption of Ordinance 93-1 in order to provide no less than 15 days for the public to inspect the entire Code Book prior to the April, 1993, Town Board meeting.

ORDINANCE-Chapter 6

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT PER SEC. 66.30 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CAMERON AND THE TOWN OF STANLEY

THE TOWN OF STANLEY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. MUNICIPAL COURT

1) <u>Municipal Court Created</u>

There is hereby re-created and established a Municipal Court under provisions of Chapter 755 of the Wisconsin Statutes to be designated as the Joint Municipal Court for the Town of Stanley and the Village of Cameron.

2) <u>Municipal Judge</u>

Such court shall be under the jurisdiction of and presided over by a Municipal Judge, who resides in the Town of Stanley or the Village of Cameron. Such Municipal Judge shall be elected at large in the spring election for a term of two (2) years commencing on May 1. All candidates for the position of Municipal Judge shall be nominated by nomination papers as provided in Sec. 8.10, Wis Stats., and selection at a primary election if such a election is held as provided in Sec. 8.11, Wis. Stats. The Town of Stanley and the Village of Cameron shall provide for a primary election in the event for such position of Municipal Judge as provided in Sec. 8.11(1)(a) Wis. Stats., and such primary election shall be held on the third Tuesday of February as provided in Sec. 5.02(22) Wis. Stats.

3) Elections

The Municipal Clerk of each municipality shall see to the compliance with Secs. 5.58(1c), 5.60(1)(b), 5.60(2), 7.10(1)(a), 7.60(4)(a) and 8.10(6)(a) Wis. Stats. to provide for the election of a Municipal Judge under Sec. 755.01(4).

4) Oath and Bond

The Judge shall, after election or appointment to fill a vacancy, take and file the official oath as prescribed in Sec. 757.02(1), Wis. Stats., and at the same time execute and file an official bond in the amount as per agreement by the governing body. The Judge shall not act until oath and bond have been filed as required by Sec. 19.01

(4)(c) Wis. Stats., and the requirements of Sec. 755.03
(2) have been complied with.

5) Salary

The salary of the Municipal Judge shall be fixed by Town of Stanley and the Village of Cameron which shall be in lieu of fees and costs. No salary shall be paid for any time during the term during which such Judge has not executed the official bond or official oath, as required by Sec. 755.03, Wis. Stats. The municipalities may by separate ordinance or resolution, allocate funds for the administration of the Municipal Court pursuant to Sec. 66.30 Wis. Stats.

6) Jurisdiction

The Municipal Judge of the Municipal Court shall have such jurisdiction as provided by Secs. 755.045 and 755.05 <u>Wis. Stats</u>., and as otherwise provided by State Law.

7) Hours

The Municipal Court shall be open at such location and at such times determined by the Municipal Judge.

8) <u>Forfeitures</u>

The Municipal Judge may impose punishment and sentence as provided by Chapter 800 Wis. Stats., and as provided in the ordinances of the Town of Stanley and the Village of Cameron. All forfeitures, fees, penalty assessments and costs shall be paid the the Treasurer of the Municipality within which the case arose within days after receipt of the money by the Municipal Judge or other court personnel. At the time of the payment, the Municipal Judge shall report to the Treasurer the title of the action, the offense for which a forfeiture was imposed, and the total amount of the forfeiture, fees, penalty assessment and cost, if any.

9) <u>Contempt Procedure</u>

- a. The Municipal Judge may impose a sanction authorized under Section 800.12(2) for contempt as defined in Sec. 785.01(1) Wis. Stats., in accordance with the procedures under Sec. 785.03 Wis. Stats.
- b. The Municipal Judge may impose a forfeiture for contempt under Sec. 800.12(1) Wis. Stats. in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 or, upon non-payment of the forfeiture and the penalty assessment under Sec. 165.87, Wis. Stats., a jail sentence not to exceed 7 days.

10) Abolition

The Municipal Court hereby established shall not be abolished while this Section 755.01 (4), Wis. Stats. agreement is in effect.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from May 1, 1993, with election to be held April 7, 1993.

At fiscal year end, a review of all citations issued for the Town of Stanley shall be reviewed, at that time the Village of Cameron and the Town of Stanley will discuss an amount to be paid for time involved in processing all tickets.

Upon request of either municipality this agreement shall be reviewed for changes, prior to Municipal Judge's election.
