

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

between

City of Rice Lake

and

Town of Stanley

Regarding the Jurisdiction of the Portions of 19th Street within the Town of Stanley

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. 66.0301, this Agreement is entered into this 23 day of March, 2022, by and between the City of Rice Lake, a Wisconsin municipal corporation, with an address of 30 E. Eau Claire Street, Rice Lake, Wisconsin (the "City"), and the Town of Stanley, a Wisconsin municipal corporation, with an address of 2026 15th Avenue, Cameron, Wisconsin (the "Town").

1. **Purpose:** The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth an agreement regarding jurisdiction, maintenance, repair, improvements, snowplowing, ditch maintenance, etc. of those portions of 19th Street currently under the jurisdiction of the City and located in the Town, as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A (collectively, the "Street"). It is the City's and Town's intent that the Town have sole jurisdiction over and responsibility for the Street, for which it can provide resources more efficiently.
2. **Term:** The term of this Agreement shall commence upon execution of this Agreement by both parties (the "Execution Date") and will remain in effect until such time that the agreement is terminated by both parties to this Agreement agree in writing.
3. **Town Jurisdictional Control of Access, Speed Limits, Improvements, etc.** It is the intent of both parties to this Agreement that the Town shall at its cost be responsible for all maintenance of the Street and shall have jurisdictional authority to control speed limits; access design and location; any improvements to the Street; applying for grants related to improving the Street; and making any other decisions related to the Street. The Town will confer with the City regarding location and design of accesses to any property in the City. The Town shall be entitled to all general transportation aids relating to the Street.
4. **Entire Agreement and Amendment:** This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties relating to the maintenance and jurisdictional control of the Street. No party has relied upon any statements, promises, or representations that are not set forth in this document. This Agreement may be amended only upon the mutual written agreement executed by both parties.



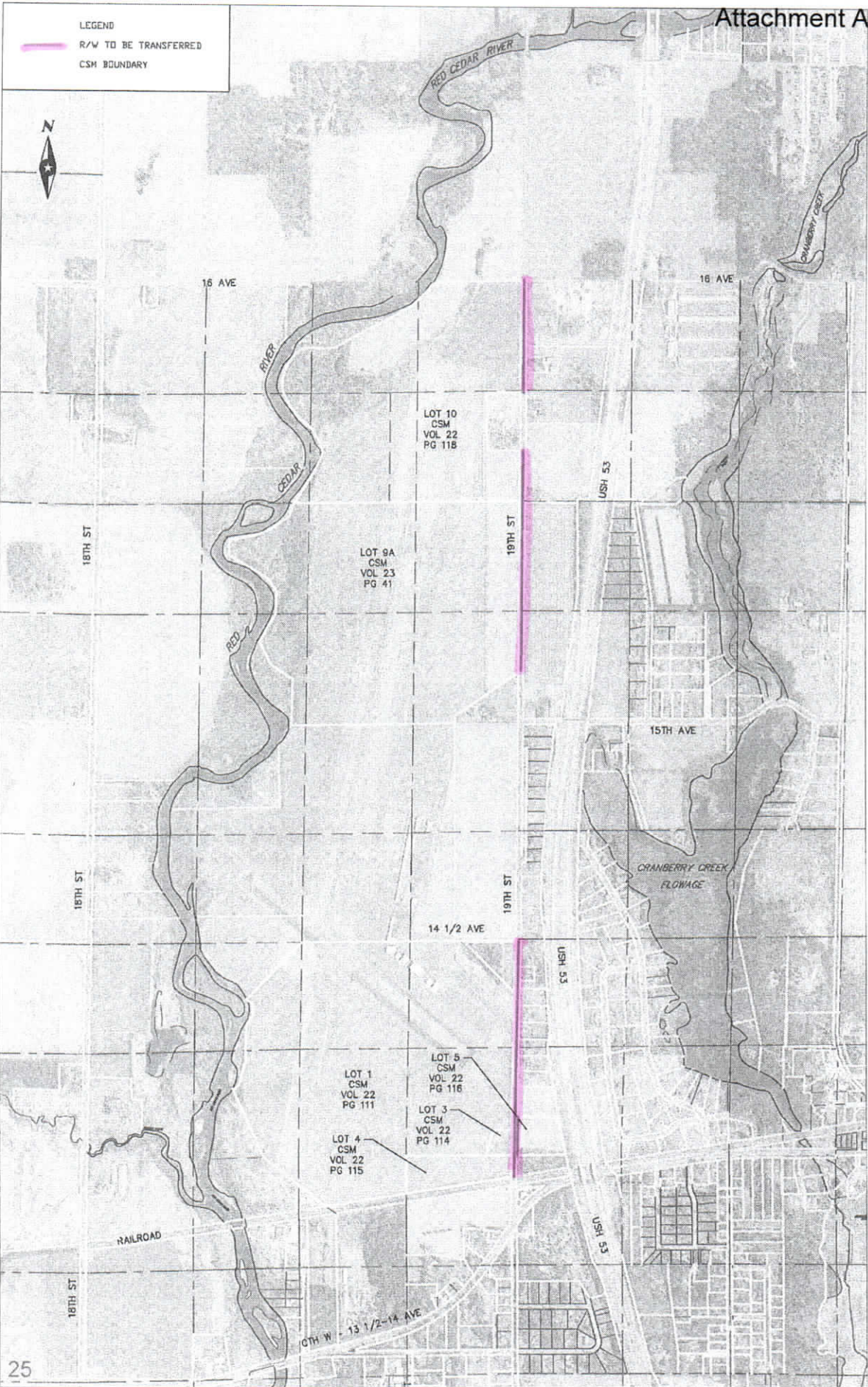
